



Town of Ponoka Snow and Ice Control Update

Town of Ponoka snow and ice control crews are busy sanding and salting roadways throughout the community today, as well as clearing snow from priority routes.

Crews are also sanding, salting and conducting snow clearing operations on sidewalks adjacent to Town-owned properties, as well as on walking trails and park furniture (benches, picnic tables, etc.) in Town parks and throughout the trail system.

Motorists are encouraged to slow down and drive for winter conditions. Snow and ice control crews will continue to monitor intersections and roadways throughout the community.

To report an icy intersection, back alley or snow-covered sidewalk that may need attention, please submit an online service request by visiting ponoka.ca/p/online-service-request. You can also phone 403-783-4431 where Town staff can help fill out the online form for you.

Please note that Town winter operations crews work in conjunction with the Alberta Ministry of Transportation and Economic Corridors, which is responsible for snow and ice control on Highways 2A and 53 in Ponoka.
