

Town of Ponoka Snow and Ice Control Update – Wednesday, December 18

Town of Ponoka snow and ice control crews are sanding, salting and conducting snow and ice control operations on Town roadways throughout the community today where needed. As the snow continues to fall, crews will continue to monitor roadways and intersections throughout Ponoka.

Crews are also sanding, salting and clearing snow on sidewalks adjacent to Town-owned properties, as well as on walking trails and park furniture (benches, picnic tables, etc.) in Town parks and throughout the trail system.

Motorists are encouraged to slow down and drive for winter conditions. To report an icy intersection, back alley or snow-covered sidewalk that may need attention, please submit an online service request by visiting ponoka.ca/p/online-service-request. You can also phone 403-783-4431 where Town staff can help fill out the online form for you.

Please note that Town winter operations crews work in conjunction with the Alberta Ministry of Transportation and Economic Corridors, which is responsible for snow and ice control on Highways 2A and 53 in Ponoka.
