The Monthly Property Tax Payment Plan automatically withdraws the monthly payment from your bank account on either the first or 16th business day of each month. There are no additional fees or interest charges.

Outdoor Winter Recreation in Ponoka

Winter weather means outdoor activities like skating, tobogganing, cross-country skiing, and enjoying a crisp, refreshing stroll along the 10 kilometres of walking trails in Ponoka.

Outdoor Skating



Outdoor Skating Rink (ODR) 4410, 54 Street

- Open in the daytime and in the evening. The ODR outdoor lights operate from 5 to 10 p.m.
- Indoor changerooms can be accessed at the north end of the Ponoka Arena Complex and are available from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Skating Trail at Lions Centennial Park *Highway 2A, north of Highway 53*

- The skating trail can be accessed from the northend gazebo at Centennial Park.
- The ice trail is for public skating only. Hockey is not permitted.

Tobogganing and Sledding

Tom Hamilton Memorial Hill 6706, 36 Avenue

At the Ponoka Kinsmen Recreation Park, which is located on the west end of 36 Avenue in the Froman Industrial Park.

Cross-Country Skiing

Ponoka Golf Course 3519, 46 Street

 The starting and finishing point is down below near the member cart shed. Please stay on the trails at all times.

• Christmas Tree Pickup Begins January 21 - The Town will make one pass down each back alley in Ponoka to pick up compostable Christmas trees that have been placed outside for collection. Ponoka residents are asked to place their Christmas tree for pick up at their back alley or in front of their property no later than Monday, January 20.
