

## Protect Your Ride and Register Your Bike

The Town of Ponoka and the RCMP have partnered to create an online bike registry that aids in returning stolen bikes to their rightful owners.

You can register your bike online on the Town website at [Ponoka.ca/p/register-your-bike](https://ponoka.ca/p/register-your-bike) (please sign up or log in using your recreation account). You can also register in person at the Ponoka Aquaplex (5315 46 Avenue) or the Ponoka Arena Complex (4410 54 Street) or by phone at 403-783-0131.

When you register your bike, you will be asked to provide the make, model and serial number of your bike, along with your contact information.

If your bike is stolen, report it to the RCMP and your bike registry profile will be shared with the police. To report your stolen bike, please call 310-RCMP (7267). You can also report your stolen bike through the Alberta RCMP app (found on Google Play or the Apple Store) or online at [Ocre-sielc.rcmp-grc.gc.ca/alberta/en](https://ocre-sielc.rcmp-grc.gc.ca/alberta/en)

- **Green Cart Weekly Collection** – Weekly pick up of green carts begins for the season starting the first week of May and will continue until November 1, 2026. Please place compostable items only in your Green Cart (compostable yard waste and kitchen scraps). No household garbage or plastic bags please.
- **Waste Transfer Summer Hours** – Starting May 1, the Town of Ponoka Waste Transfer Station will switch to summer hours, which are 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Summer hours will continue until October 31, 2026.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on April 15, 16 and 17 - depending on your Zone.
- **Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on April 22, 23 and 24 - depending on your Zone.
- **Missed Pickups** - If your curbside green or grey cart was not picked up on your collection day, please contact E360S dispatch at 403-341-9300 or by email at [rddispatch@E360S.ca](mailto:rddispatch@E360S.ca).
