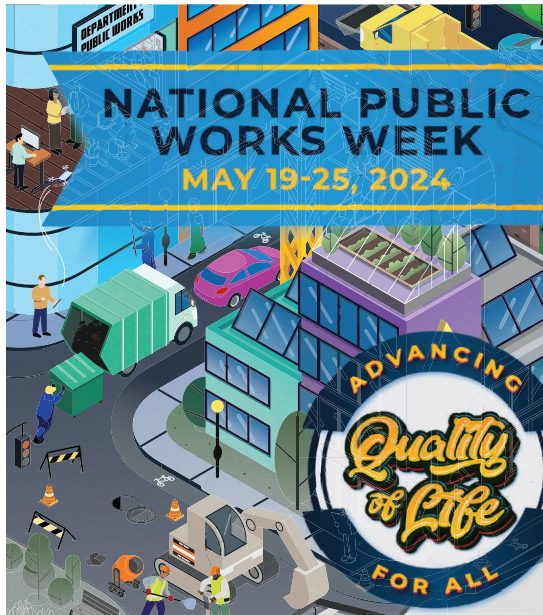

- **How to Report a Pothole** – To report a pothole that needs to be filled on Town of Ponoka roadways, please submit an Online Service Request on the Town website at [Ponoka.ca](http://Ponoka.ca). Click the 'Service Request' button under 'File an Online Service Request' and fill out the form. You can also phone the Town Office at 403-783-4431 where Town staff can help fill out the online form for you. To report potholes on Highway 2A or Highway 53, which are provincial roadways, please contact the Alberta Ministry of Transportation at 403-340-5166.
- **Recently Issued Development Permits** – To view a list of the most recent development permits, please visit the Town's website at [Ponoka.ca/p/development-permits-and-decisions-issued](http://Ponoka.ca/p/development-permits-and-decisions-issued)
- **Green Carts and Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up on May 22, 23 and 24 - depending on your Zone.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on May 29, 30 and 31 – depending on your Zone.
- **Missed Pickups** – If your curbside recycling, green cart or grey cart was not picked up on your collection day, please contact E360S dispatch at 403-341-9300 or by email at [rddispatch@e360s.ca](mailto:rddispatch@e360s.ca).
