What Goes in My Recycling Bag?

Recyclable items that can be placed at the curb in clear or blue transparent bags include:

- Clean tin/aluminum cans and plates;
- Clean cardboard;
- Paper:
- · Non-glass drink containers; and
- · Plastics with recycling symbols



Please do not place glass, Styrofoam, plastic bags or lids (except recyclable plastic or tin can lids) in your recycling.

All recyclables must be rinsed and cleaned. All labels and lids must be removed.

Deposit beverage containers (including milk cartons) can be taken to the local bottle depot for a full refund or placed at the curb for recycling.
