- **Badminton**


Please note: Programming will be unavailable on August 10, 21 and 22.

- **Positive Ticketing Program Ongoing in Ponoka** – The Positive Ticketing Program focuses on youth in the community and rewards them for demonstrating safe behaviour when doing things like riding their bicycles. - **Green Carts and Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags should be placed at the curb for pick up August 14, 15 and 16 - depending on your Zone.
