The Town of Ponoka is seeking applicants for a full-time permanent Equipment Operator 1 position for the Parks, Recreation and Facilities Services Department.

Duties and responsibilities of this position include:

- Assist user groups and provide information to patrons;
- Operate and maintain ice making and servicing equipment in the Complex and in outdoor areas as required;
- Provide routine janitorial and building maintenance duties;
- Operate and maintain sprayers, mowers and other equipment used in park and boulevard maintenance;
- Operate and perform routine maintenance on light mobile equipment engaged in parks and recreation facilities;
- Provide general laboring and other duties as required.

To be effective in this role, applicants require the following knowledge and skills:

- Operation and maintenance of skid steers, tractors, mowers, zambonis and other small mobile equipment;
- Ice-making and on-going maintenance of ice surfaces;
- Grass and tree maintenance;
- Facility clean-up and maintenance;
- Excellent communication skills;
- Valid Class 5 Operators License;
- Arena Operator Level 1;
- Parks & Sportsfields Operator Level 1.

Salary: as per AUPE agreement Class 13, \$23.79 to \$27.56 per hour

Hours of Work: Working 40 hours per week, the successful candidate will be primarily placed at the Arena Complex working a three week rotational schedule consisting of day, night and weekend shifts during the fall and winter months. Shift schedules will be dependent on operational needs.
