

1. Now that recreational cannabis is legal, what are some of the rules and regulations related to cannabis that I should be aware of?

- To buy, possess or use cannabis, you must be of legal age (18 or older) in Alberta.
- You can only purchase cannabis from licensed stores or online at www.albertacannabis.org.
- 30 grams is the most you can buy or carry at a time.
- Only four plants can be grown per household.
- Driving high is illegal.
- If you have cannabis in a vehicle, it must be in a sealed package and out of reach of all occupants in the vehicle.
- Edibles are not yet legal to sell.
- Children can't enter cannabis stores, even with an adult.
