

TOWN OF PONOKA EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I

The Town of Ponoka is currently seeking applications for a permanent full-time Equipment Operator I (Parks & Recreation).

Duties and responsibilities of this position include:

-) Assist user groups and provide information to patrons
-) Operate and maintain ice making and servicing equipment in the Complex and in outdoor areas as required.
-) Provide routine janitorial and building maintenance duties.
-) Operate and maintain sprayers, mowers and other equipment used in park and boulevard maintenance.
-) Operate and perform routine maintenance on light mobile equipment engaged in parks and recreation facilities.
-) Provide general laboring and other duties as required.

To be effective in this role, applicants require the following knowledge and skills:

-) Operation and maintenance of skid steers, tractors, mowers, zambonis and other small mobile equipment;
-) Ice-making and on-going maintenance of ice surfaces;
-) Grass and tree maintenance;
-) Facility clean-up and maintenance;
-) Excellent communication skills;
-) Valid Class 3 Operators License is required (air brake endorsement preferred)

Successful Candidate will be required to submit a satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check.

Salary: As per AUPE agreement Class 13, \$23.79 to \$27.56 per hour

Hours of Work: Working 40 hours per week, the successful candidates will work primarily at the Arena Complex on a three week day/evening/weekend rotation during the fall and winter months and work in Parks & Recreation, Monday to Friday (day shift) during the spring and summer months. Shift schedules will be dependent on operational needs.
