- Protect Your Ride and Register Your Bike** – The Town of Ponoka and the RCMP have partnered to create an online bike registry that aids in returning stolen bikes to their rightful owners. You can register your bike online on the Town website at Ponoka.ca/register-your-bike (please sign up or log in using your recreation account). You can also register in person at the Ponoka Aquaplex (5315 46 Avenue) or the Ponoka Arena Complex (4410 54 Street) or by phone at 403-783-0131. When you register your bike, you will be asked to provide the make, model and serial number of your bike, along with your contact information.
- Mini Makers Classes (Ages 5 to 8)** – Unleash your child's creativity with local artists every Tuesday from May 5 to 26 from 4 to 5 p.m. Each week, they'll dive into a new art form, build confidence and create one-of-a-kind pieces to take home. - Waste Transfer Summer Hours** – Starting May 1, the Town of Ponoka Waste Transfer Station will switch to summer hours, which are 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Summer hours will continue until October 31, 2026.
- Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on April 29, 30 and May 1 - depending on your Zone.
- Green Carts and Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags and carts should be placed at the curb for pick up on May 6, 7 and 8 - depending on your Zone.
