Understanding Your Property Tax Bill

In the combined assessment and property tax notice, the Town of Ponoka is required to collect:

- ✓ **The municipal property tax** - Ponoka Town Council worked hard to keep the municipal property tax increase at 2% for 2026, which is **lower than inflationary cost increases**. Municipal property taxes pay for important municipal services like roadways, emergency services, parks and recreation. These services help keep the Town of Ponoka running and support quality of life in the community.
- ✓ **The Alberta Government's education tax** - the Government of Alberta increased its education tax for the Town of Ponoka by 11% for 2026. *This represents about 25% of the increase to residential property taxes this year and more than a third of the increase for non-residential property taxes.* The Town of Ponoka is required to collect the provincial education tax and send the funds directly to the Alberta Government.
- ✓ **Rimoka Housing Foundation requisition.**
