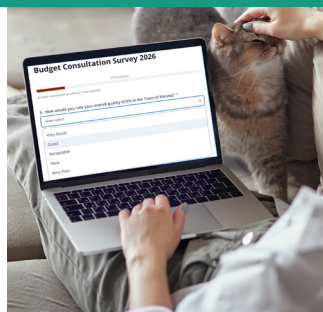


# We Want Your Input on the 2027 Town of Ponoka Budget
