- **Property Taxes are Due July 31** - Citizens have until Friday, July 31 to pay property taxes without penalty. If you want to pay your property taxes in monthly installments for no additional fee, contact the Town Tax Clerk before July 31 at 403-783-0127 or by email at taxes@ponoka.ca or visit [Ponoka.ca/monthly-property-tax-payment-plan](https://ponoka.ca/monthly-property-tax-payment-plan). Property owners are responsible to ensure their taxes are paid on time and to contact the Town if they do not receive their tax notice.
- **Green Carts and Recyclable Materials** bundled in clear or blue transparent plastic bags and carts should be placed at the curb for pick up on July 15, 16 and 17 - depending on your Zone.
- **Grey Carts and Green Carts** should be placed at the curb for pick up on July 22, 23 and 24 - depending on your Zone.
